












Welcome Salmon La Sac Sno-Park Groomed Trail System

Area has 6 kilometers of groomed cross country ski trails. Distance labeled between intersections.

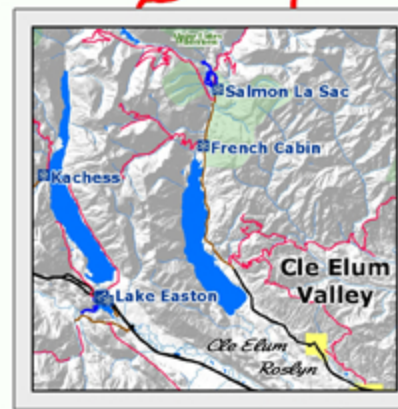
